The Forest City Y offers quality before and after school childcare program called YMCA Kid's Club. The program also offers care during no school days and during the summer months. We strive to provide a supervised, safe and caring before and after school environment for children grades K—5th. # YMCA Kids Club

The YMCA Kids Club is housed at the Forest City YMCA and offers a safe, supervised location for children grades K-5th to hang out before and after school. YMCA Kids Club also offers all day summer care called Summers Rock at the YMCA.

## Daily Schedule

For before school care, children will begin their day at the YMCA. Following breakfast, children will be walked or transported via transit bus (during inclement weather) to the elementary school. Children will be met after school in the gymnasium by Y staff and be walked or transported via transit bus (during inclement weather) back to the YMCA where a snack will be served and activities will begin.

## How to Register:

Complete enclosed registration forms and emergency information sheet for each child to the Y front desk. New families will be assessed a one-time registration fee of \$25/Y member or \$40/program member.

## YMCA Kids Club Staff:

Ava Pauley will serve as the YMCA Kids Club Coordinator. Ava has served as the school-aged care coordinator for 20 years. Ava will be assisted by high school and college age staff. Staff are carefully screened and complete all required trainings.

## Payment Policies:

Payments are due on Friday of each week for the prior week. Payment must be received in full for your children to continue in the program. \$10 late fee will be added for bills not paid by Friday. \$25 fee will be added for returned Payments. **Automatic bank draft is only method of payment unless other arrangements are made.** Complete a bank deduction form and return to the front desk.
