The Summer Rocks program provides a fun and safe environment for your school age child during the summer with a daily planned activities including outdoor play, art projects, gym games, swimming and weekly field trips.

How to Register:

Returned the completed registration forms and emergency information sheet for each child to the Y front desk.

Summer Schedule:

Children will be grouped in 3 different age categories. Age categories are determined by the grade they will be going into in the Fall of 2017.

- 1-2 graders will be on the second floor of the YMCA and 3-5 will be in the multi-purpose room

Summer Themes/Fieldtrips:

Summer field trips will be planned in addition to daily activities. Field trip fees are not included in weekly rates. Fees will be collected on the day of the field trip. Permission forms will be distributed at the beginning of the summer. **Please note that there is NO CARE for children that do not attend field trips.**

Payment Policies:

Payments are due Friday of each week. Payment must be received in full for your children to continue in the program. Automatic bank draft is preferred method of payment. Complete the form and return to the front desk.

- Rates are on a contract basis. You will be charged if your child is here or not, with the exception of the Annual Shut-Down week <and Winnebago shutdown>?. Payments will be due weekly on Fridays. Automatic bank deduct is the preferred method of pay. A \$10 late fee will be added if not by Friday. The Y also reserves the right to suspend care until account is paid in full.
- If your child attends on a non-scheduled day, he/she will be charged \$30/day per child, payable the day attending.

Meals:

Children will receive breakfast and afternoon snack. Children will walk to FC Elementary to participate in the free lunch program. On days that the free lunch program is not operating, children will need to bring a sack lunch. The school will provide lunch on field trip days.

What to Bring:

Please mark all items of clothing and personal belongings with child's name

- Appropriate dress for active/messy play
- Swim suit and Towel
- Fees for field trips and extra spending money if desired

What Not to Bring:

- Video Games/tablets
- Personal snacks; unless discussed with the Coordinator
